Did you know that colorectal cancer is the third most common cancer in both men and women?

Often, colorectal cancer begins as a non-cancerous polyp or growth. These polyps can usually be found and removed before they turn into cancer. That's why it is important to get screened. Generally, adults at average risk should schedule their first colonoscopy at age 45 and continue every 10 years if the results are normal.

New cancer center opens at McLaren Greater Lansing

Clinicians at McLaren Greater Lansing's new \$600 million health care campus began treating its first patients at the new outpatient care center and Karmanos Cancer Institute on February 28. The historic event was marked by a ceremonial ribbon cutting attended by leaders from McLaren, Michigan State University (MSU), Karmanos Cancer Institute, MSU Health Care, clinicians, support staff, construction workers, and elected officials.



"Today marks the beginning of a new chapter in McLaren and Michigan State University's history of collaborating on caring for the communities we serve, advancing medical research, and training the next generation of caregivers to serve our patients in mid-Michigan and beyond," said Phil Incarnati, President and CEO of the McLaren Health Care system.

"The possibilities of a greater partnership between McLaren and MSU combined with a common vision for healthy communities led to the creation of this new, next-generation health care campus. With nearly 900,000 square feet of new inpatient and ambulatory care space, this project is the largest capital project in our system's history and one of the largest single investments in the health of the greater Lansing community ever."
