- Sites: 1 = McLaren Flint
- Days Off: Residents are allowed up to 20 weekdays off in the academic year, which are typically taken during electives. Numbers of days off listed in the diagram above constitute the total weekdays allowed off within the block.
- IMRGP Clinics: Every resident is scheduled in their half-day continuity clinic at IMRGP once a week in every week of training excluding night float and critical care core rotations with additional clinics built-in to primary care rotations during training. Residents are also added into extra clinics during electives to meet the program's requirements for continuity care.
- Hours/Shift: Hours listed above are an estimated max number per shift based on rotation schedule and work hour logs; not including weekend shifts.
- Critical Care Rotations: Critical care rotations are Pulmonary and ICU training with some experiences in CCU.
- Primary Care Experiences: These outpatient experiences occur in the IMRGP Clinic as well as arranged experiences with McLaren Flint physicians within the following specialties: Allergy & Immunology, Bariatrics, Dermatology, Gynecology, Neurology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, PM&R, Podiatry, Psychiatry (Behavioral & Addiction Medicine), and Pulmonary Rehab. Additional experiences in these specialties are available as electives.
- Longitudinal Experiences: Exposure to the following is built into the program's longitudinal curricula: Cardiology, Dermatology, Endocrinology, GI, Infectious Disease, Medical Genetics, Nephrology, Otolaryngology, Palliative Medicine, Rheumatology, and Sleep Medicine. Additional experiences in these specialties are available as electives.
- Electives: All electives in the program are individualized learning experiences. Only 1 away elective can be completed during the three years of training, which is optional in PGY-2. Residents are unable to repeat an elective in the same specialty within the same year of training unless given prior written permission from program administration. Residents on electives may be assigned weekend guest shift coverage within work hour rules.
