

TRAUMA SERVICES

McLaren Greater Lansing's trauma center is available to ensure the best possible outcomes in a life-threatening or other time-sensitive emergency when it arises.

- Trauma activation criteria are in place to provide safe and efficient provision of care to all trauma patients including: firearm and other penetrating injuries, motor vehicle accidents, falls, drownings, etc.
- Provide prompt assessment, resuscitation, stabilization, and surgical intervention, and intensive care if necessary.
- 24-hour on-site coverage by board certified emergency medicine physicians, hospitalists, and critical care specialists.
- Prompt availability of trauma surgeons, orthopedic surgeons, anesthesiologists, neurologists, and other specialists.
- ICU and trauma unit staffed with registered nurses trained to provide specialized care to injured patients.



LEVEL III TRAUMA CENTER

McLaren Greater Lansing offers 24-hour on-site coverage by board-certified emergency medicine physicians and the prompt availability of general surgeons and anesthesiologists. We have established transfer agreements for patients requiring a higher level of care at a Level I or Level II trauma center.

We also offer continuing education to our nursing, allied health, and trauma team members. We continue to be involved with prevention efforts and have an active outreach program for our referring communities.

STROKE AND ANEURYSM SERVICES

McLaren Greater Lansing offers a telemedicine service that provides patients with in-house stroke care and 24/7 access to highly specialized interventional neurologists. Interventional neurologists utilize a telemedicine “robot” to provide consultative services within minutes of notification by onsite emergency and in house physicians. The TeleStroke System allows the interventional neurologist to review CT images, review clinical therapies such as thrombectomy, and discuss best options with onsite physicians, the patient, and the patient’s family.

At McLaren Greater Lansing, we provide immediate, specialized care for various types of strokes.

Ischemic Strokes:

Clot-Busting Medication (Thrombolytic Therapy): Patients who qualify for and receive this IV medication, which helps dissolve the clot causing the stroke, are admitted and cared for here.

Patients Not Eligible for Clot Removal: If the patient is not a candidate for clot-busting medication or mechanical thrombectomy (a surgical procedure to remove the clot), they will be admitted and treated at McLaren Greater Lansing.

Specialized Clot Removal (Mechanical Thrombectomy):

If our stroke specialists determine that you could benefit from a mechanical thrombectomy (a procedure to physically remove a large blood clot from the brain), you will be transferred to another facility that provides these specialized neuro-interventional services (a higher level of care).

Hemorrhagic Strokes:

Since January 2026, McLaren Greater Lansing has capability of caring for many hemorrhagic stroke patients by providing medical and surgical intervention in partnership with Lansing Neurosurgery.



- A dedicated unit for stroke patients, staffed with neuro-trained RN's able to provide specialized care to stroke patients.
- An educated, multidisciplinary team of physicians with neurosurgeons on-call, medical director, stroke-certified nurses, a clinical coordinator, and physical/occupational therapists.
- Emergency Department prepared to treat stroke patients immediately with thrombolytic (clot-busting) therapy.
- Stroke alert process for rapid triage of patients with signs and symptoms of stroke.
- Radiology technicians ready to carry out emergency tests to determine type and location of stroke.
- Neurological services are provided by MSU neurology program. Neurology coverage is provided 24/7/365.
- McLaren neuro-interventionalists are board certified by the United Council of Neurologic Sub-specialties for Interventional Neurology. They are also board certified in stroke, neurology and neurocritical care.


