PUBLIC DISCLOSURE – ACO PARTICIPATION WAIVER

McLaren High Performance Network, LLC participates in the Medicare Shared Savings Program as an accountable care organization (ACO). We are dedicated to improving the quality of care and outcomes for our Medicare beneficiaries and lowering their health care costs. To accomplish these objectives, we have developed care management plans that encourage prevention and early detection of disease. We also have developed initiatives to assist beneficiaries as they transition from one site of care (e.g., hospital) to another site (e.g., home). These care management plans and initiatives rely upon the timely exchange of health information between us and our providers. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) measures our performance, and we collect and submit health care quality and outcomes data electronically to CMS.

CMS and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office of Inspector General have made available certain waivers of specific fraud and abuse laws for accountable care organizations participating in the Medicare Shared Savings Program. McLaren High Performance Network, LLC has established the following arrangement for protection under the ACO participation waiver:

Physician Technology Integration Support –

We have engaged a vendor who has developed an electronic interface between the ACO and the electronic health record systems of ACO participating physicians. The interface is expected to improve care management and beneficiary outcomes by accessing clinical data. The interface will also promote electronic submission of clinical data to the ACO and CMS. The ACO may provide a one-time stipend to ACO participating physicians to help cover the technology-related implementation costs that are incurred with this initiative.

The parties to the arrangement include the vendor of the electronic interface and the ACO participating physicians that choose to join the integration initiative.
